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The *Insurance Journal* recently published a video clip highlighting Hinshaw partner Scott Seaman's panel discussion at the 2025 InsurerTech Summit. As described by the *Insurance Journal*, Scott emphasizes that while legal risks surrounding artificial intelligence (AI) in insurance do exist, the more pressing issue is ensuring that insurers are leading with AI rather than merely reacting to it.

He argues that robust AI capabilities—developed and overseen by knowledgeable professionals—are essential for compliance and success in the evolving insurance industry. Despite limited federal regulation, the real risk stems from flawed implementation, inadequate oversight, and a lack of human control. From underwriting to fraud detection and navigating social inflation, Scott believes the strategic use of AI will shape future industry leaders.
