

Tom McGarry Quoted in Chicago Daily Law Bulletin Article on In-house Counsel Amnesty

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Chicago — Thomas P. McGarry, a Hinshaw & Culbertson LLP partner was quoted in a December 17, 2013 [Chicago Daily Law Bulletin](#) article titled “In-house Counsel Get Law License Amnesty.”
