

Raylene DeWitte Grischow Re-Appointed to Illinois Supreme Court Committee on Professional Responsibility

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SPRINGFIELD, IL. — The Illinois Supreme Court has re-appointed Raylene DeWitte Grischow, a partner in the Springfield, Illinois, office of Hinshaw & Culbertson LLP, to a two-year term as a member of the Court's Committee on Professional Responsibility (Committee). The Committee advises and makes recommendations to the Court on matters relating to legal ethics and professional responsibility.
