

## David Alfini and Adam Guetzow Author Article on Electronic Monitoring in Long-Term Care Facilities

That statute was signed into law on August 21, 2015 and represents Illinois' most significant legislation on the subject. In the course of the article, the authors provide an in-depth analysis of: the Act and, generally, comparable laws; those statutes' implications and requirements; and how facilities falling within the purview of such laws (or similar ones passed in the future in other jurisdictions) might address legal compliance.
