

Kristen Perkins Discusses the “Surge” of ADA Lawsuits against Banks with American Banker

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Hinshaw partner Kristen Perkins was quoted in an *American Banker* article titled “Banks are sitting ducks for ADA lawsuits.” The article discusses the suits brought against fifty-one banks in 2018 alleging their websites violate the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

“Plaintiff’s attorneys are using software specifically designed to detect website flaws,” Perkins said, “[if] they find any level of noncompliance, then you can be sued.”
